Week 4 - Tell your Story

Monday:

Read Acts 1:1-9. Jesus' final instructions to the disciples were to be his witnesses. Pray that God will remind us as a church to take these instructions seriously. Pray that God will empower you to be a witness.

Tuesday:

Witnessing means telling the story of what you have experienced. A witness simply tells the truth about what they have seen. Take a moment to reflect on what God has done in your life. How have you seen God at work? How have you witnessed the goodness of God? How has the good news of Jesus changed your life?

Wednesday:

Read John 4:1-26, 39-42. Notice verse 39. Many of the Samaritans believed in Jesus because of the woman's testimony. Pray that God will use your testimony in the same way.

Thursday:

Many people won't know the good news of what God done unless we share our stories. Who in your life doesn't know God? Write their names below and pray over them. Ask God to give you clear opportunities to tell them your story.

Friday:

On Sunday, we'll be challenged to live out the DNA of FCC. We will commit to tell our stories by praying for one person and inviting them to church. Pray about who you need to invite to church. Pray for the church as we prepare to make commitments to the DNA of FCC next week.
